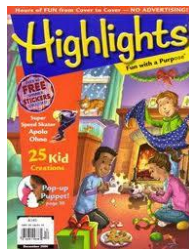
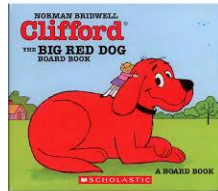


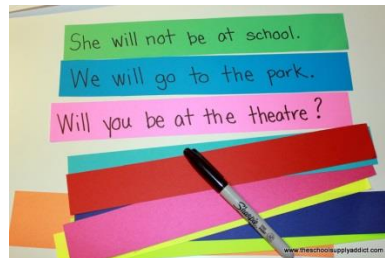
Sentence Scramble Activity

Great review of sentence structure, using spelling words in sentences, and capitalization and punctuation usage.

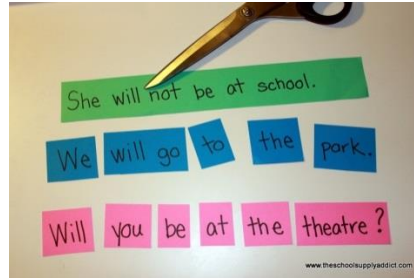
- Choose a sentence that your child can read from a picture book, chapter book, magazine, or newspaper.



- Copy the sentence onto colored paper (index paper, construction paper) *** see below for a variation if no colored paper is available*



- Cut the sentence apart between each word. Leave the punctuation attached to a word, if need be. *(Hint: words can be chunked together for beginning readers)*



- Have your child try to put the sentence back together! Have fun!

***If you do not have any colored paper on hand, no worries! You can write each sentence out on white paper with different color markers or crayons. ***
